CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Euphrasia Training College, Provincial Superior, Udaya Provincial House, Irinjalakuda-680125, Thrissur District, Kerala vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F. KL/SEC/N/167/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/775 dated 23.02.2005 for conducting Secondary course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 24.01.2015 & for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 15.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 (One basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter of institution was considered in 369<sup>th</sup> meeting of SRC held on 28<sup>th</sup> January 2019 and decided to issue SCN all such cases for withdrawal of recognition. Accordingly, a SCN dtd. 26.03.2019 was issued. The institution has submitted the reply on 03.04.2019 and 26.06.2019.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 377<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 03<sup>rd</sup>-04<sup>th</sup> July and the Committee decided to issued Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 12.07.2019. The institution has submitted reply on 02.08.2019.

5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 07<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> January 2020 decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Euphrasia Training College for Women, Thrissur - 680702, Kerala for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued on 22.01.2020. Thereafter, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-69/E-158751/2020 Appeal/12<sup>th</sup> Mtg. 2020 July 2020 dt. 15.09.2020 confirms the order appealed against.

6. AND WHEREAS, the order dt. 25.09.2020 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam in W.P. No. 18749/2020(P). The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 389<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> & 14 October 2020 and the Committee decided issue letter. Accordingly, Letter was issued on 19.10.2020. The institution has submitted its reply on 19.10.2020. The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 391<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 03<sup>rd</sup> November, 2020 and the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Euphrasia Training College, Provincial Superior, Udaya Provincial House, Irinjalakuda-680125, Thrissur District, Kerala for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session

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under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly, Withdrawal order was issued on 09.11.2020. Thereafter, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-14/E-174297/2020 Appeal/7<sup>th</sup> Mtg. 2021 23 February 2021/97000 dt. 12.03.2021 appeal remain back the order appealed against. The institution submitted its reply 23.03.2021. The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 397<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on March 25<sup>th</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup> 2021 and committee decided to issue withdrawal order. Accordingly letter was issued on 05.04.2021. The institution has submitted its reply on 11.04.2021.

7. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 400<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> July 2021 and the Committee decided as follows:-

"The original files of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the institution Euphrasia Training College, Survey No. 7781/1, 778/2, 778/10, Kattoor Village, Mukundapuram Taluk, Kattoor Panchayat, Irinjalakuda, Thrissur District-680702, Kerala for B.Ed programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students"

9. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. Euphrasia Training College, Survey No. 7781/1, 778/2, 778/10, Kattoor Village, Mukundapuram Taluk, Kattoor Panchayat, Irinjalakuda, Thrissur District-680702, Kerala for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for (1 basic unit) of 50 students each subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 2 lakhs kept in part account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the F.Ds or mortgaging them shall not be done.
  - The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
  - The institution shall make admissions only after B.Ed. exam affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 9(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedures) Regulations, 2014.
  - The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
10. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee in itself - Annual Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
12. The institution shall maintain its Website with by; submit to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of

the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
  - Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
  - Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last quarter;
  - Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
  - Fee charged from students;
  - Available infrastructural facilities;
  - Facilities added during the last quarter;
  - Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
  - The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
  - The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
  - Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
13. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
14. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
15. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
